

LIBRARIES

University of Alberta Hospital Site

The John W Scott Health Sciences Library is located on the second level of the Walter Mackenzie Centre in 2K3.28. Phone: 780-492-3899. Library hours vary throughout the year and are posted outside the entrance doors. Apart from major holidays, the library is open seven days a week. You will require a ONEcard to access the library's resources. Many of the library's information resources are now available in electronic form including close to 700 electronic health sciences journals, Medline, EMBASE, MD-consult, Scientific American and Harrison's Online, etc.

Royal Alexandra Hospital

The library has extensive services and is part of the NEOS Consortium. Hours are 8:00 am to 4:15 pm, Monday to Friday. The library is closed on weekends and statutory holidays. Phone: 780-735-5832.

Misericordia Community Hospital and Health Centre

The Weinlos Library, located in the northwest corner of the first floor, has a good selection of medical texts, references and AV materials. Hours of operation are 8:00 am - 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Phone: 780-735-5708.

To obtain access to the Internet, e-mail, word processing, Medline, EMBASE and the University of Alberta library, you will need a University of Alberta GPU account. E-MAIL

A University of Alberta GPU account will be opened for all PGME trainees. Your Campus Computing ID (CCID) and password will be provided to you by email once you are registered with the University.

Instructions on how to activate the account and change your password will be included. **Mail from the University of Alberta will be sent to your GPU account only, including notices of awards, general announcements, etc.** Your CCID will be required to access all library computers. If you wish to use another e-mail address, it is incumbent upon you to make the necessary arrangements to forward e-mail from your GPU account to another address.
