

UROLOGY RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITY

4th Year and Elective Student Assignments

Site Assignment

- Maximum of 12 students (including electives at one time)
- UAH and RAH will have equal number of students assigned by the Program office

Chief/Senior Residents Role

- Each morning the chief/senior resident at the UAH/RAH site will meet and round with all students (4th year and electives) at 0700hrs
- 4th year students will be assigned to one site on a one-week rotation
- Elective students can still be assigned to other clinical staff and activities, should it improve the overall exposure of urology in Edmonton to them and/or they have an interest/or requested to see more

Students are required to see the following:

- 3 days of Office Clinic
- 2 days of OR
- 1 day of Cysto
- 2 days, at minimum of on call duties – assigned to a schedule

Optional for students to see include:

- 1 day of Litho
- 1 day of a Pediatric Clinic
- 1 day of Urodynamics

Evaluations

- 4th year students will be responsible for collecting 360 evaluations from nurses, residents and surgeons during their urology rotation
- Elective students will still be assigned a preceptor, who they will be responsible for spending a majority of their time with to complete their elective requirements
