

## **RESIDENCY TRAINING COMMITTEE**

The resident research committee would be comprised of members of the clinical research unit and research director for the division of urology. The role of this committee would be to review resident research and report monthly to the residency committee on progresses being made by the residents.

The rotation coordinators committee would comprise of the coordinators for each specific rotation. Each coordinator would be called to report to the residency training committee on current concerns and/or issues with the specific rotations. The committee would call only one coordinator to report per meeting, allowing for two years to progress between reviews of rotations.

This committee is responsible for the development, maintenance and evaluation of the program including:

- €# Clinical rotations
- €# Teaching sessions and seminars
- €# Visiting professors
- €# Selecting new residents
- €# Allocating funds to resident travel, books etc.
- €# Hearing appeals of evaluations
- €# Supervision of research projects
- €# Ongoing faculty evaluation
- €# Ongoing rotation program and rotation evaluation
- €# Resident evaluation.
- €# Resident career development.

The members of the committee include the following. Each member will have one vote privilege pre item with final decision being with the chairman.

1. Program Director (chairman)
2. Divisional Director
3. Teaching coordinator from University Hospital
4. Teaching coordinator from Royal Alexandra Hospital
5. Teaching coordinator for Caritas Hospitals
6. Resident representatives from PGY years 3 and 5
7. Past Program Director will serve for a minimum of one year in an advisory role  
*(each member will have one vote privilege per item with final decision being with the chairman)*

Ex-Officio Members will include the following. These members can be invited to attend meetings and/or report to the committee but are non-voting members.

- Associate Dean of the Postgraduate Medical Education Office
- Coordinator of Undergraduate Medical Education
- Member of the Research Committee.
